

Nursing Facility Admission Criteria for the Justice Involved Population

MissionCare Health locations are privately owned skilled nursing facilities that care for individuals who meet nursing home level of care criteria and who are difficult to place because of a history of mental health disorder and/or criminal history or other stigma.

It should be clear that a nursing facility is the most appropriate, least restrictive setting for the individual being evaluated for placement. There should also be evidence that other, more traditional nursing facilities will not consider the individual for admission.

In addition to the MissionCare assessment process, Federal law requires that all individuals undergo a Preadmission Screening Resident Review (PASRR). Admission is ultimately determined by review of the above factors, consideration of the milieu and at discretion of the MissionCare team in consideration of the greatest likelihood of successful resident placement.

Please consider the following information in review of a justice involved individual or population for skilled nursing placement:

Physical Location and Legal Status

Current Location Insurance Designated Conservator of Person or Estate

Medical Diagnoses

Basic medical information and demographics to include history and physical exam, diagnostic tests, physical and occupational therapy evaluations, medication lists, nurses notes, behavioral and other care plans
COVID-19 History with Vaccine Information
Wounds
Requirements for Isolation unrelated to COVID (example, MDROs)
Hospitalization in the last 60 days?
Specialty durable goods and equipment

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Dialysis Presence of Substance Use Disorder with Type and Frequency

Assistance with Activities of Daily Living

Does this person requires assistance w/ personal Care Bathing Dressing Toileting Transferring Ambulation Eating Meal Preparation Medication administration

Psychiatric and Behavioral Factors

Diagnoses Psychotropic medications Behaviors and date of last episode Psychiatric Hospitalizations Mini Mental Status Exam Historical or Current Behaviors including: Assaultive Behavior Harm to Self, up to specifically Suicidal Harm to Others, up to specifically Homicidal Arson Sexual Inappropriateness Unplanned Leave or Elopement Risk Other

Risk Mitigation Summary from Parole

Registry Status and Court Ordered Requirements Inmates full criminal history, police report of current arrest or charges Victim Notification Requirements

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Disciplinary Record including Tickets and Violations Known or suspected gang affiliation Cross check of inmate vs. current residents Prior Living Arrangement

Factors mitigating need for GPS monitoring:

Requires extensive assistance with ADLs including the use of mechanical equipment to transfer him in and out of bed.

Is currently being cared for on a secured unit.

Access control to the facility is safeguarded by a secured door, access control (keypad and camera system).

Has not expressed a desire to leave the facility against medical advice or not in coordination with a formalized discharge plan.

Mechanism of Release: Medical Parole Compassionate Parole End of Sentence (with or without probation) Probation/parole officer assignment/involvement

Current factors that may mitigate documented or potential risk

Cognitive deficits such as memory, orientation or level of attention or persistence Detailed care plan Balance or ambulation status Coordination Strength Paralysis Amputation Respiratory Endurance Range of motion Sensory or other deficits

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
